BATHING REGULATIONS

Thermal water is THE natural remedy of Thermalbad Wiesenbad. The motto here is: "It's the dose that counts". Bathers with stable health can bathe for up to 2 hours. Bathers with cardiovascular diseases should start with a shorter stay and possibly consult their doctor beforehand.

1. access to the thermal bath *Therme Miriquidi*

The current tariffs for admission to the thermal baths can be found in the valid house brochure. In addition, the tariffs are publicly displayed at the reception of the thermal bath.

By purchasing an admission ticket, the bathers accept the bathing regulations and follow the instructions of the supervisory staff. Bathers who have not purchased an admission ticket are not permitted to enter the thermal bath.

Access to the thermal baths is generally permitted to everyone for private leisure purposes during opening hours. Commercial use requires the prior consent of the management. Admission for children up to the age of 10 is possible when accompanied by an adult.

For special occasions (e.g. baby swimming, aqua fitness courses, etc.), the use of certain pools in the thermal baths may be restricted. Participation in these offers is only permitted to registered bathers.

2. changing room / locker key:

You will receive your locker key with your admission ticket. You will need to leave a deposit of at least €10 at the reception desk of the thermal baths. After your stay in the thermal bath, you will also receive your deposit back against return of the locker key. Valuables can be left in the valuables box at the reception of the thermal baths, no liability is accepted for valuables or your clothing brought in.

The loss of the locker key must be reported immediately to the supervisory staff of the thermal baths or to the reception of the thermal baths, stating the key number. A fee of €10 will be charged for each lost key.

3. swimwear:

The stay in the thermal bath is only allowed in usual bathing clothes. Wearing wetsuits, T-shirts, beach shorts and Muslim swimwear (e.g. burkini) is not permitted for hygienic reasons. Wearing bathing shoes is prohibited in the individual pools.

4. body hygiene:

Cleanliness in the thermal bath is the top priority!

Before entering the swimming hall, a thorough body cleansing under the shower with removed swimwear as well as the disinfection of the feet under the foot spray system is mandatory. Please tie up long hair or protect it with a bathing cap.

Bathers with open wounds and / or skin rashes are not allowed to enter the thermal bath.

5. aqua aerobics:

Aqua aerobics are offered to all bathers during the regular opening hours of the thermal bath.

However, there is no entitlement to implementation. The offer can be cancelled for an important reason (e.g. assistance), there is no entitlement to a refund or reduction of the entrance fee. Bathers are advised to participate only to the extent that their health permits. The operator accepts no liability for injuries or health restrictions resulting from participation in water gymnastics.

6. behaviour in the thermal bath:

Not allowed in the entire area of the thermal bath:

- smoking or drinking alcohol
- pollution of the thermal water
- reservation of loungers with towels etc.
- taking photographs or taking other visual or audio recordings
- bringing or using glass objects
- entering with street shoes
- Running, romping and making noise as well as diving, jumping, using water balls, rubber animals, flippers and diving goggles
